

Overview of Ohio's Current Graduation Requirements

Students Graduating Spring 2018 & Beyond (Current Grade 9 & Grade 10)

The graduation requirements include curriculum (credits) and three options to show readiness for next steps in college and career readiness.

College & Career Readiness Options

1. Industry credential and workforce readiness.

Students earn 12 points through a State Board of Education approved, industry-recognized credential or group of credentials in a single career field and achieve a workforce readiness score on the WorkKeys assessment.

2. College admission test

Earn a remediation-free scores in English Language Arts and Math on a nationally recognized college

admission exam.

3. Ohio's State Tests

Earn 18 cumulative points on the 7 Ohio State Tests. Students can earn 1-5 points based on their performance. Students earning HS credit in any of these courses prior to July 1, 2014 will automatically earn the transcript grade for those courses.

Students must earn at least:

- o 4 points between Math tests
- o 4 points between English tests
- o 6 points between Science & Social Studies tests
- Need 4 additional points to make 18 total (any combination)

Students Graduating Spring 2016 & 2017 (Current Grade 11 & Grade 12)

Students will continue to operate under original graduation requirements using the OGT testing requirement as well as the earning the minimum 20 required courses.

**Beginning January 1, 2016 students may have the choice to use Ohio's new graduation options to earn a diploma. This allows students to take an End of Course exam in the area of OGT still needing a proficient score. A score of 3 must be earned on the End of Course exam to be counted towards graduation.
